

General Information

Time of Collection: To ensure your recycling and rubbish materials removal, please place the rubbish on the opposite side of your driveway from the recyclables, by **6:00 A.M.**



Day of Collection: Recycling and rubbish materials will be picked up on the same day each week EXCEPT when a holiday falls on or before your regular pick up day. Then your recycling and rubbish materials will be collected one day late.

HOLIDAYS THAT AFFECT COLLECTIONS ARE THE FOLLOWING:

New Year's Day, Memorial Day, July 4th, Labor Day, Thanksgiving Day, Christmas Day

Containers:

The standard trash containers are 96 gallon and 68 gallon. A second container is available at additional cost. Contact Allied Waste for details at 440-458-5191.

Container placement: Place containers within 3 feet of the curb with the arrows facing the street, and at least three feet apart.

Note: Do not place containers at the curb prior to 5:00 P.M. on the day before collection. Please remove empty containers within 12 hours after collection.

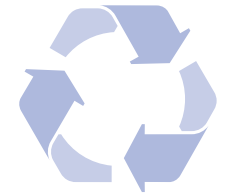

Amherst Township Recycling and Rubbish Rules and Regulations for Single Family Homes and Condos

*If you reside in a multi-family complex these rules and regulations may not apply to you.

In order to minimize the cost of collection, mechanized trucks will now be used for trash and recycling collection. All your general refuse and recyclable materials must be placed in the containers provided. No other containers or bags of trash will be taken.

Trash and recycling containers will be delivered the week of January 5th, and only the containers should be placed out on your next scheduled pick up day.

PERMITTED REFUSE

- Yard Waste
- Food Waste – drained, wrapped and placed in a plastic bag.
- Other trash – juice boxes, paper containers, waste paper, etc.
- Sharp items, broken glass, syringes, etc.
Place in puncture-proof container prior to placing in cart.

ITEMS BELOW PICKED UP ON THE 2ND FULL WEEK OF THE MONTH ON REGULAR PICKUP DAY

- Household furniture, carpeting, cut and rolled into 4' lengths etc.
- Tables, swing sets, and television sets, etc.
- Refrigerators, freezers – DOORS REMOVED – FREON REMOVED
- Window AC Units & Dehumidifiers – FREON REMOVED
- Washers and dryers
- Christmas trees picked up the second full week of January

NOT PERMITTED AT CURB

- Large car parts, tires, batteries, etc.
- Liquids
- Extra bags or cans of trash or recyclable materials

NOTE: CONTRACTORS ARE RESPONSIBLE FOR REMOVAL OF BUILDING MATERIALS AND DEBRIS

ATTENTION SENIORS:

Should you wish to continue with bagged trash collection please contact our office and a trash cart will not be delivered to your residence. A small cart will be delivered for your recyclable material collection.

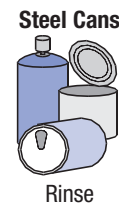
Recycling Rules & Regulations

A GREEN 68 GALLON CART WILL BE PROVIDED FOR ALL YOUR RECYCLABLE MATERIALS WHICH INCLUDE:

Cardboard, newspapers, junk-mail, magazines, cereal boxes, glass bottles and jars, aluminum and steel cans and numbers 1 and 2 plastics. Place all items loose in recycling cart.



Green recycling containers will be delivered the week of January 5th and must be utilized for all your recyclable materials.



NOTE: Do not jam items into cart or overstuff container

Items Excluded From Recycling Collections

Window glass, light bulbs, drinking glasses, mirrors or ceramics, and plastic containers that are contaminated, i.e. motor oil, antifreeze, pesticide and herbicide containers and those with food. Place above items and empty containers in trash container.
